has grown to more than three dozen criminal charges of raping, molesting or sexually violating four different patients.

He also pleaded not guilty to special allegations of violating business and professional codes.

The number of victims has increased since his initial arrest, and his criminal complaint has been amended.

Prosecutors are now expected to reveal the evidence during a preliminary hearing in September.

During the time of these alleged incidents, Anderson worked at a US HealthWorks office on Folsom Boulevard. He is no longer employed there and his medical license has been temporarily suspended.
